Reminder on the Veterinary Governance Project



Veterinary Governance at a glance



- **10th EDF**
- **30 Million €**
- **47 ACP countries - 7 RECs** (+ non ACP states for common positions issues)
- **Intensive consultations** with all stakeholders during the preparation phase
- Project under preparation. Foreseen start date: **early 2011**
- **Specific objective:** Improve the institutional environment at national and regional levels to provide effective and efficient animal health services in Africa



Result areas:

Result 1: Knowledge and awareness for institutional change enhanced

Result 2: Institutional capacity for livestock policy formulation, animal health strategies and legislation enhanced

Result 3: Institutional capacity for the implementation of policies and enforcement of regulations enhanced



Implementation



- 3 contribution agreements (IBAR, OIE, FAO)
- OIE in charge of quality control on PVS pathway and Capacity building on Vet. Legislation.
- FAO in charge of support to policy analysis and strengthening regional networks
- AU-IBAR in charge of :
 - Advocacy and awareness
 - Support to RECs – Capacity building
 - Inter regional harmonization



Implementation



– RECs are both:

- **Beneficiaries:** supported to enhance their capacity to provide support to countries and play harmonization/coordination role
- **Impl. Partners:** will provide capacity building and backstopping to countries
- IBAR will **second officers** to RECs
- **MoU and contracts** will be signed between RECs and IBAR

– Countries are target beneficiaries



Governance organs



Continental Project Steering Committee :

- **Chair:** the AUC-Com REA (African ownership, alignment with CAADP)
- **Secretariat:** IBAR
- **Members:** ACP Secretariat, implementing partners, RECs, main stakeholders & development actors in the sector, EU
- **Role:** strategic guidance, oversees coherent implementation of the different agreements and monitor progress



Governance of the Project



Project Management Committee:

- **Chair:** Rotational IBAR, FAO, OIE
- **Members:** 3 impl. Partners + RECs
- **Secretariat:** IBAR
- **Role:** ensure that activities are synchronised, sequenced and inter-related

Regional Advisory Committees:

- **Chair :** REC
- **Members:** 3 partners, countries
- **Role :** ensure consultation and coordination with and among Member states

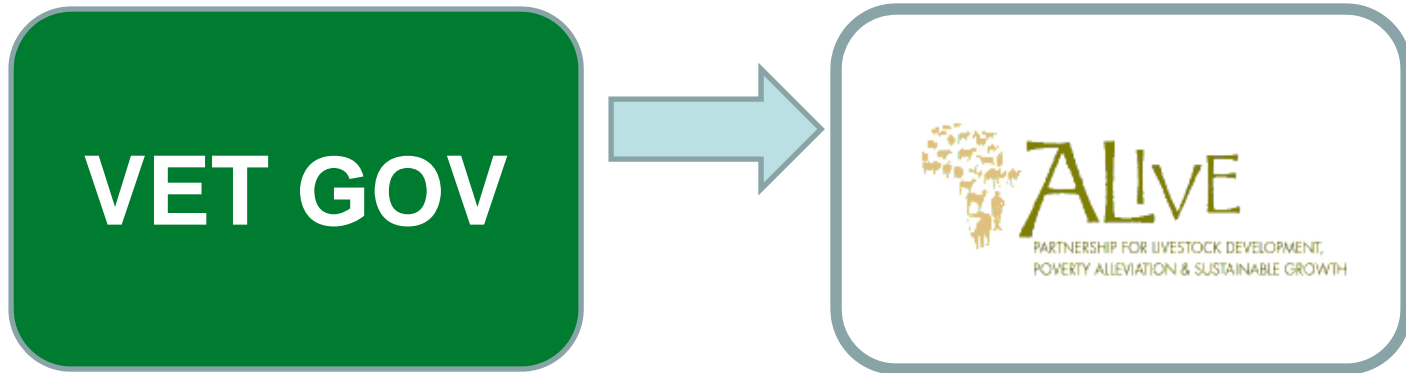

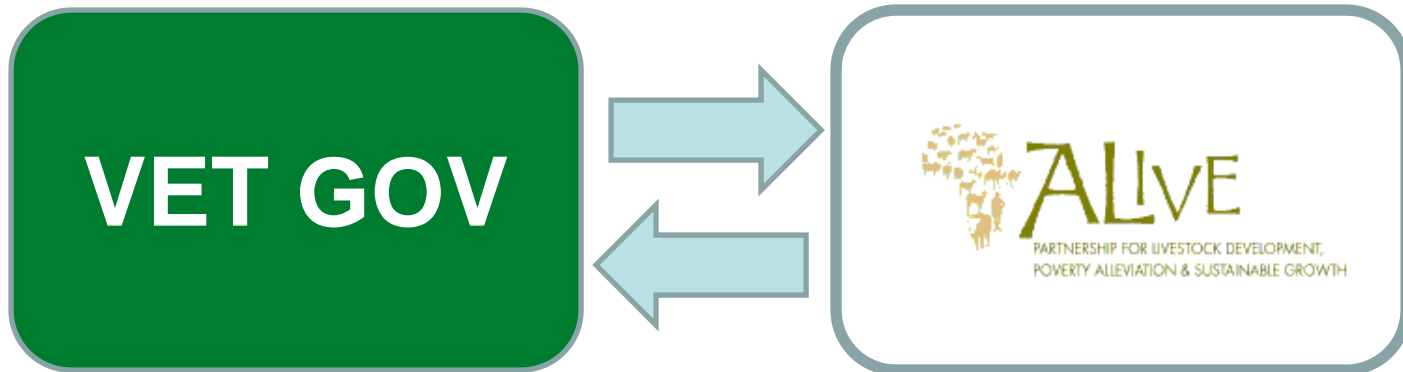

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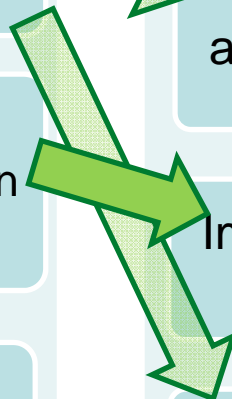
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Vet Gov contribution to ALive



- **VET GOV will support directly:**
 - Secretariat activities (EC, GA, running costs), except staff costs
 - 2 policy briefs /year
- **VET GOV activities**
 - Will contribute to achievements of ALive core functions
 - Could be considered as TAP activities?



Alive contribution to Vet Gov



- **ALive will benefit to Vet Gov:**
 - As a coordination platform to ensure synergies of Vet Gov activities with others
 - to ensure compliance of Vet Gov activities with the agreed ALive's common approach and strategy.
 - to share outputs of studies, policy guidelines and policy tools, and enlarge their dissemination
 - As awareness raising tool



VET GOV and GF-TADs Africa



- **GF-TADs Africa is considered as the TADs component of Alive**
- **Alive will support the costs of GF-TADs Africa governance (SC meeting back to back with Alive EC)**
- **GF-TADs Africa will be used as a coordination and information sharing platform for Vet Gov TEDs related activities**
