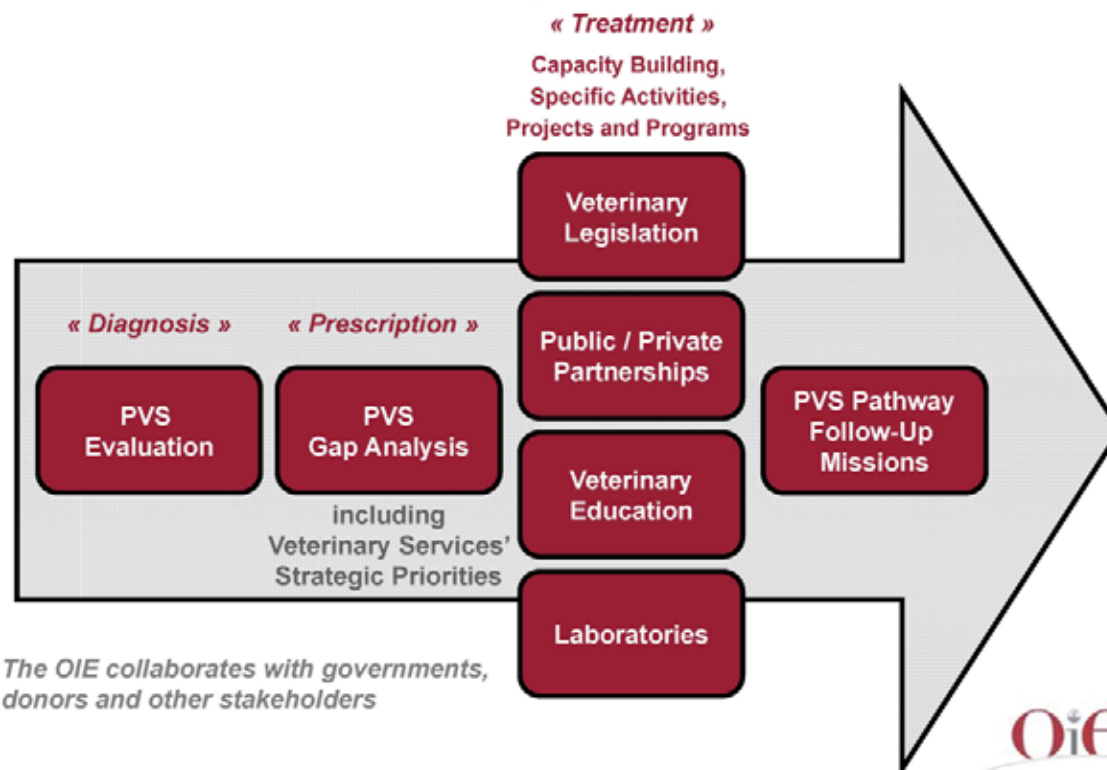

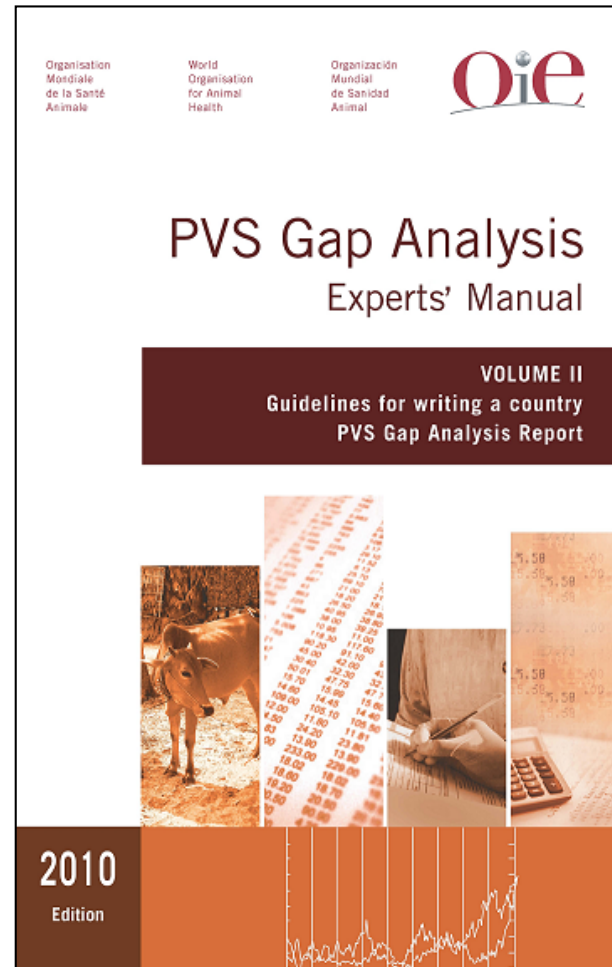
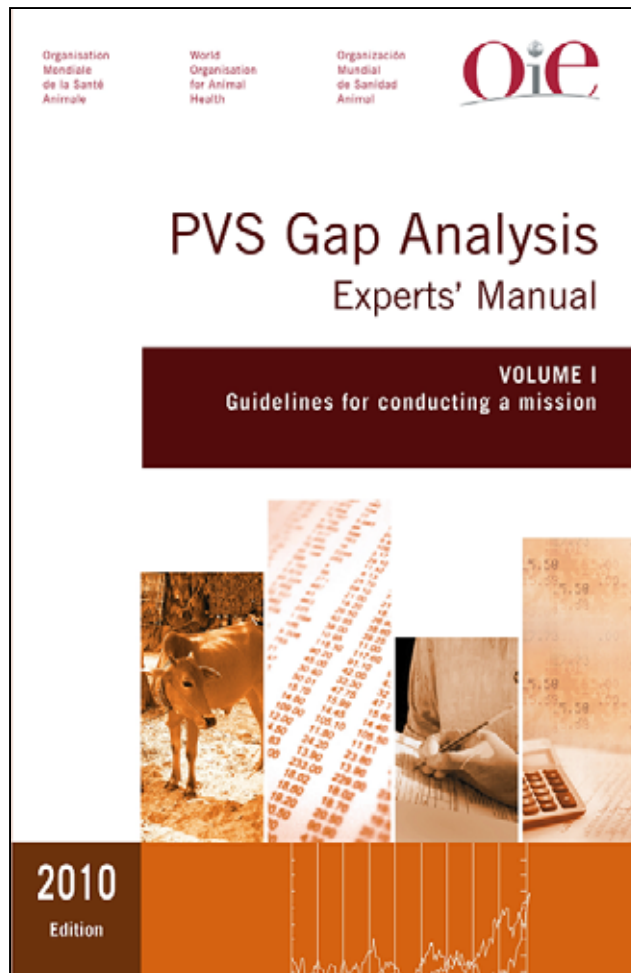
## The OIE PVS Pathway

- No PVS follow-up evaluation mission requests have been received from Africa to date



- Priority diseases and regions
- Geographical coverage (special effort for developing countries and countries in transition)
- Better global disease surveillance
- Improvement in compliance with international standards (OIE)
- Access for more countries to carry out high-level diagnosis and expert valuations > high detection / rapid response
- Build and maintain a scientific community in beneficiary countries

**21 projects signed to date; average duration:  
28 months**
