Communication – advocacy – “inter EC” activity of the platform

- Working Plan of the ALive Secretariat for the next 6 months with timeline (list of meetings – conference to be attended / steps – process in implementing recommendations...)
- Decision-making process on ALive secretariat priorities for the next 6 months ?
- Followed up by short minutes / major recommendations
- Regular interactions – consultations of EC members (peer reviews – request for opinions...)

- Function 4 “access to global knowledge” –
 - Is there a demand ? Donors’ caucus feel: yes
 - Comments reflect probably the lack of outputs on this function
 - How to better involve stakeholders of the platform having a mandate in this function ?

→ **should not abandon the function and nor remove it form operational guidelines**

- Transfer responsibility from EC members to caucuses: **not convinced about the principle: how ? Which responsibility ?**
- Broaden membership in the caucuses ?
Financial constraints – already possible according the operational guidelines, but attendance on own-expenses of new members. RECs may delegate one of their member State as their representative ?

- Relationship with CAADP ?
 - Improvements in the past 2-3 years (invitation of NEPAD rep. in the ALive AG, livestock included in most of country compacts...) but:
 - Organize back-to-back meetings CAADP/ALive
 - CAADP/NEPAD speaker during next ALive AG
- Communication of outputs / visibility of the partnership / increased involvement of RECs & countries
 - Secretariat to develop template presentation of ALive, its mandate and activities/outputs to be submitted to EC members for amendments/endorsement
 - ALive members, including AU-IBAR and RECs, to use this presentation during conferences, experts meetings and workshops
 - ALive secretariat to generate a database of existing knowledge by key thematic areas (e.g. AH, pastoralism, value-chains...)
